In April, St. Mark's Food Cupboard saw 52 people at our door, 19-59 years of age 34, 60+ 18 visitors. This number is down from previous months however we are endeavoring to gather accurate numbers that reflect the true need in our community so have begun to record the number of dependents at home. Our new system reflects in addition to the person at our door but as well children they are supporting. The number for April, ages 0-18 was 33. We are an emergency food source, though we try to add small extras for the children i.e.; drink boxes, granola bars, we always direct clients to the Orangeville Food Bank. We are currently in need of pasta, pasta sauce, fruit cups, apple sauce, granola bars and drinking boxes. Thank you for your ongoing support.
